Jekaterina Rostovtseva was announced as the best young piano teacher of the year 2014 which was organized by the Estonian Piano Teacher Association.

In 2022 Jekaterina got the Pedagogical recognition from Cultural Endowment of Estonia.

The students of Jekaterina Rostovtseva have won in various republican and international competitions in Italy, France, Latvia, Serbia, Slovenia, USA, China, Spain, Germany, Czech Republic, Lithuania, Estonia, Russia, Israel. Her students have been participated in some important musical festivals such as Lille Piano Festival, Piano City Milano, Festival Brin d'Herbe in Orleans, France. Jekaterina Rostovtseva also has been a member of the jury of international competitions for young pianists. Jekaterina was awarded many teacher's prizes in different piano competitions in Europe.

She is currently a lector of the Institute of Interpretation Pedagogics in the Estonian Academy of Music and Theatre, a piano teacher at Tallinn College of Music and Ballet (MUBA) and the Old Town Music School in Tallinn.
